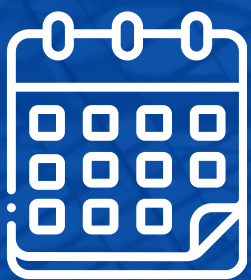

PROFESSOR ENRIQUE M. SORIANO III

is a World Bank/IFC Governance Consultant, Columnist, Book Author, Former Chair, and Professor of Global Marketing at the ATENEO Graduate School of Business.
