Answer TWO questions

- 1. Neurodegenerative diseases such as Alzheimer's, Frontotemporal and Lewy Body are unique in terms of pathology and psychological outcomes. With reference to at least two diseases, describe and assess these differences.

- 3. Learning and memory depend on plasticity at the cellular level and connectivity at the network level. Discuss.
