1. The practice of 'late customization' has received a good deal of attention in recent years in connection with Physical Supply Chain Management.

Critically evaluate the thinking behind this, including in your answer information on the benefits or disadvantages that commonly arise from the adoption of the practice. Devise a detailed illustrative example of an actual supply chain where late customization is employed.
