Macfour Pharma plc developed a new product a flu vaccine some time back and

granted the right to sell under the Macfour trade mark to two companies: one in Spain

and one in the Italy. Macfour Pharma plc kept the French market as well as the exports

of the vaccine to outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

Four months ago, the Spanish company reported to Macfour that their products were

appearing independently on the Spanish market. The goods had been purchased in

France and South Africa from pharmaceutical wholesalers and transported to Spain,

where the packaging had been altered to conform to Spanish drug laws. The price in

Spain for Macfour product is 25% higher than the price in the France.

Upon making enquiry and investigation, Macfour Pharma have discovered that a

French company, Lux Pharma, are responsible for the exports to Spain. Thereupon,

Macfour have complained to the French Government. At the same time the Spanish

company made complaints to the Spanish Government as well. Along with that a joint

approach was made to the Commission to stop this movement under Art 30. MacFour

Pharma have also contacted Lux Pharma direct, but their response was that any action

against them would be contrary to the free movement of goods.
